

Arts for All: Los Angeles County Regional Blueprint for Arts Education -- FUNDING OPTIONS FOR DISTRICTS --

CALIFORNIA STATE PROGRAMS

⇒ General Purpose

Every public school district receives general purpose funding based on a combination of local property taxes and state taxes. Supports instruction based on the state Visual and Performing Arts Standards.

⇒ Categorical Funds

School districts receive additional funding earmarked for specific purposes. Supports instruction based on the state Visual and Performing Arts Standards.

Education Technology/High Tech High Schools

Provide and improve technology available for art and music (e.g. graphic arts and MIDI)

Gifted and Talented

Support for instruction in the arts to engage “gifted and talented” in the learning process

High Priority Schools Grant Program

Support for instruction in the arts to engage “At risk” students in the learning process

Instructional Materials Standards-based

Purchase state adopted text books in the visual arts and music after adoptions are current in other core subjects

Instructional Materials Funds

Purchase books, sheet music, CDs, videos etc.

Special Education

Arts instruction for IEP students, especially if attending class in the mainstream

Williams Settlement

To improve facilities and materials to upgrade arts classroom facilities and arts materials for instruction

Year Round School Incentive

Resources to provide arts instruction

⇒ Block Grants

Library Improvement

Instructional Materials Fund: Purchase books, sheet music, CDs, videos etc.

Library Materials

School Library Materials: Purchase visual and performing art books and materials

Professional Development

Advance Placement Teacher Training: Assist teachers with developing the skills to provide instruction in arts based AP classes, e.g., music theory, studio art, art history, etc.

Professional Development Institute Stipends: Assist teachers with developing tools to integrate the arts into the curriculum

Staff Development Days: Assist teachers with developing tools to integrate the arts into the curriculum

Salary Safety

High Risk Youth Education & Public Safety: Support for instruction in the arts to engage “at risk” students in the learning process

SB80 – Reappropriation (Proposition 98)

School Improvement Program (SIP): Improve instruction in the arts based on inclusion of the arts in plans developed by school site councils

School Safety Block Grant

High Risk Youth Education & Public Safety: Support for instruction in the arts to engage “at risk” students in the learning process

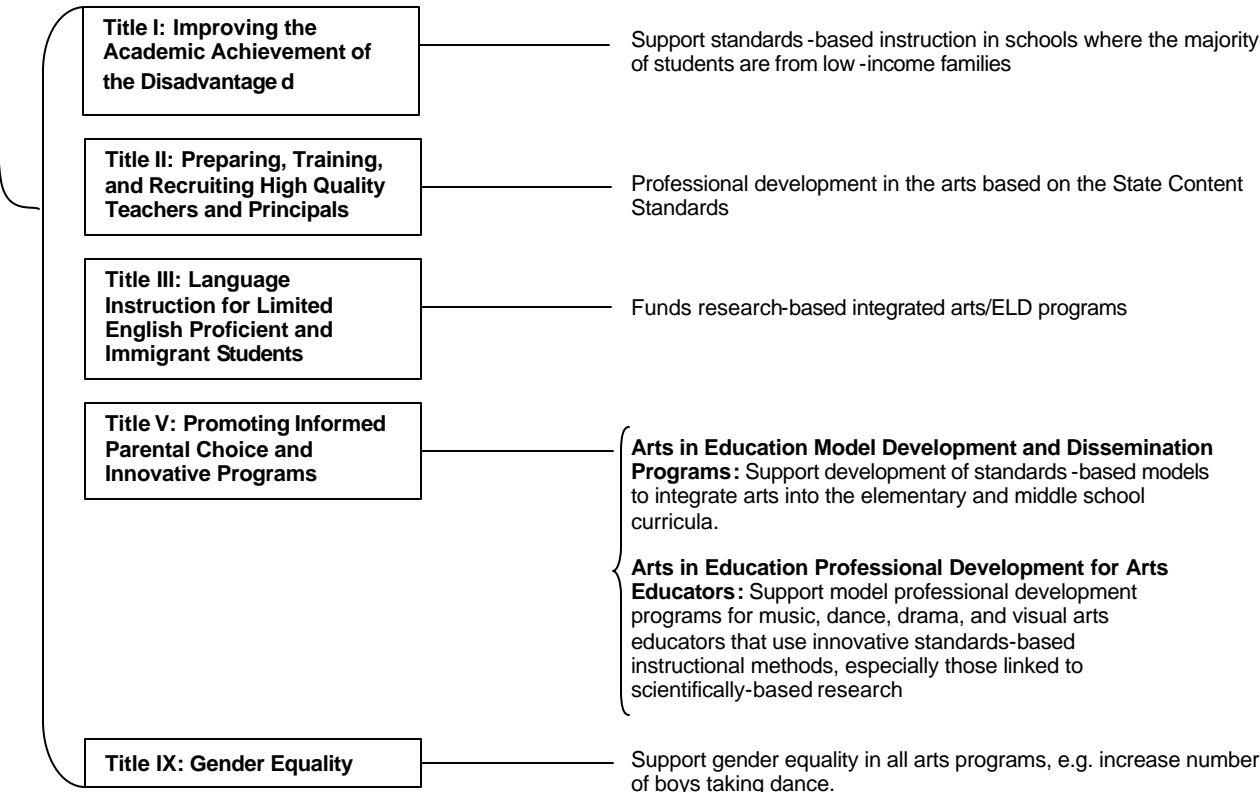
Intervention/Underperforming Schools: Support for instruction in the arts to engage “at risk” students in the learning process

Targeted Institutional Improvement

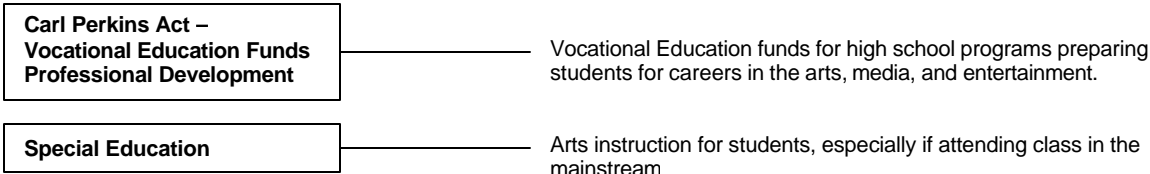
English Language Learner Implementation: Support for arts programs that support English language acquisition
